


Registering a new APNs certificate

To register a new certificate, you will need a valid Apple ID.


When this is solved, go to your user in upper right corner and select **Settings**.





Then select Apple on the left side in the menu.



Click **GET APNs** on the right side to proceed.




A **Pair with Apple** window will appear allowing you to download a Certificate Signing Request (**CSR**). Download this file and click **Next** then **Go to Apple portal** (the Apple website will open in a new browser tab).



Sign in with your Apple ID credentials



and click Create a certificate.



Click choose file and select the previously downloaded CSR file, then click **Upload**.




Vendor-Signed Certificate Signing Request


When the operation is completed click **Download** and save the .pem file.




Close the Apple website's tab, this will bring you back to Techstep Essentials MDM and click **Next** in the **Pair with Apple** window. Drag and drop the previously downloaded .pem file into the Upload certificate box and click Next.




Enter the email address for the Apple ID used above and click Finish.



When done, you should see this in the menu, include the expiration date.
